NHVTA Veterinary Technician Scholarship Application

Introduction

The NHVTA will award (4) - \$250.00 scholarships each Spring, to full time students enrolled in the Great Bay Community College, Veterinary Technology Associate's Degree Program. Two freshman students and two senior students will be selected. The scholarship award will be paid directly to your student tuition account at Great Bay Community College.

To be considered for one of the scholarships, you must meet the following criteria:

1. You are actively enrolled in the Veterinary Technology program and attending classes **full time**. This will be verified with the program director. Part time students or students on a leave of absence will **not** be eligible for the scholarship.
2. You are a current member, in good standing, of the New Hampshire Veterinary Technician Association (NHVTA). Membership is free to students.

If you are not a current member, you must submit your application and have it processed and completed **prior** to submitting this scholarship application. It takes 6-8 weeks for NHVTA memberships to be completed. Your status as an NHVTA member will be verified and if you are not a current member, this scholarship application will not be considered. 3. You have completed the scholarship application, answered all questions, fulfilled all requirements and submitted it to the NHVTA, along with all required documentation.
4. Your application has been received by the **deadline of Friday December 30, 2011**

Any application received that does not satisfy all of the above criteria will not be considered for the scholarship. You will **not** be notified of any application mistakes, errors or omissions.

1. Typed in a Word document. Handwritten essays or email text format essays will **not** be accepted.
2. Essays must be text only, single line spacing, 10 or 12 pitch font.
3. Presentation will be considered, so check for spelling and grammatical errors.
4. Essay must be printed out and submitted with the completed application.
5. Essays not adhering to this format or with excessive white space on the page will not be accepted and your application will **not** be considered.
